Please follow the instructions <u>carefully</u> and return the packet to the NCJFA PO Box address and be <u>post</u> marked no later than May 1st 2024. All (4) items below must be complete to qualify.

- 1) Complete essay form
- 2) Complete Cover Form
- 3) Complete volunteer form, use back if needed or for additional awards or commendations.
- 4) Enclose <u>official</u> 2022/23 High School transcripts. (<u>Must have school raised seal or official Stamp</u>, NO copies of stamp or seal permitted)
- 5) Complete application must be submitted together at once. Student must collect all paperwork and submit package **together**. **No Exceptions**

To ensure fairness do not put any Name, Address, or any identifying information such as Company's names or names of schools or towns, Etc. on any of the paperwork, other than **cover form** application will be voided. All papers in packets will have a # on it and will be divided before scholarship committee receives it. Please be as accurate as possible with all references. **All applicants that are being considered will have their references checked.**

In order for any Junior/Explorer to qualify for the Scholarship they must comply with the following items below.

1) Your Departments NCJFA Dues must be paid in full through 2024

- 2) You must be an active member in your Junior/Explorer group for at least 12 Months from date of application and have been an Active Junior/Explorer in good standing for at least 12 Months.
- 3) Your group must be an active member in the NCJFA
- 4) You must be a Senior in High School
- 5) You must be attending College full time and taking at least 12 Credits for September 2024 Semester.
- 6) Understand that all forms and information supplied for this Scholarship become the property of the NCJFA and will not be returned; all privacy of applicants will be maintained.
- 7) The NCJFA reserves the rights to publish names, pictures and Company information of the winner.
- 8) All information MUST BE LEGIBLE, Essay must be Times New Roman Text, at size 12 Font, double spaced.
- 9) All winners must coordinate time and place with NCJFA Board for photo for media publications.
